I MAKE the following order under Section 143 of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995*.

Short title

1. This order may be cited as the Fisheries (Research Area) Order (No.5) 2008.

Commencement

2. This order takes effect on 1 November 2008.

Research area

3. The following part of State waters (on the east coast of Tasmania approximately adjacent to the Bay of Fires) is declared to be a research area:

All waters off the east coast of Tasmania bounded in the north by the line of latitude 40° 59' 40" South and in the south by the line of latitude 41° 12' 30" South.

Restrictions on taking fish in the research area

- 4. The following restrictions on fishing are declared to apply in the research area referred to in clause (3).
 - a) A person must not take abalone.

Revocation

5. The Bay of Fires Fisheries (Research Area) Order 2005 published in the Gazette on the 23 November 2005 is revoked.

Explanatory Note

This Order modifies the existing research area at the Bay of Fires. The existing no abalone take area for all sectors remains. The area where a reduced bag limit for recreational fishers applied, and no abalone take for commercial fishers applied, is lifted. In relation to the fishing blocks used in the commercial abalone fishery, no abalone may be taken in 30C and 30B. Block 30A is now open to commercial fishing and the reduced bag limit for recreational fishers in that block no longer applies.

Information

This notice opens an additional area of the Tasmanian Scallop Fishery for commercial purposes, waters opened in a previous notice for commercial scallop fishing off Bicheno and Marion Bay remain open, all other waters are closed. The arrangements are subject to change.

Fishers should be aware, pursuant to rule 23 of the *Fisheries* (Scallop) Rules 2005 the deployment of a scallop dredge is prohibited in State waters less than 20 metres deep, scallop dredging prohibited areas (listed in Schedule 2 of the *Fisheries* (Scallop) Rules 2005) and a closed area for the commercial scallop fishery.
