Dead mussels, clams and oysters may only be imported where accompanied by a consignor declaration certifying:

- 2. that the mussels, clams or oysters have not been grown in or originate from:
 - a) an aquatic (freshwater, marine or brackish) environment in any area of New South Wales, Australia: or
 - b) an area known to be infected with Oyster Herpes Virus.

All certification must be in a form approved by the Chief Veterinary Officer, and must be presented to an inspector on the consignment's arrival in Tasmania.
