GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Administrative Arrangements (No. 2) Amendment Order 2011

This order amends the Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 2) 2011 to -

- (a) assign to the Minister for Corrections and Consumer Protection the administration of the *Motor Vehicle Traders Act 2011;* and
- (b) specify that the Department of Justice is responsible to that Minister in relation to the administration of that Act.

(2) Crown Lands Regulations 2011

These regulations -

- (a) provide for the management of public reserves under the Crown Lands Act 1976; and
- (b) prescribe certain fees payable under that Act; and
- (c) rescind the Crown Lands Regulations 2001.

(3) Health (Fees) Amendment Regulations (No. 3) 2011

These regulations amend the *Health (Fees) Regulations 2007* by revising the fees payable by or on behalf of certain persons for dental services provided to those persons in public hospitals.

(4) Proclamation under section 11(2) of the Nature Conservation Act 2002

This proclamation, made under the Nature Conservation Act 2002 -

- (a) declares certain areas of Crown land to be reserved land in the class of conservation area; and
- (b) in doing so, creates and names certain new conservation areas and extends an existing conservation area.
 - (5) Proclamation under section 11(2) of the Nature Conservation Act 2002

This proclamation, made under the Nature Conservation Act 2002 -

- (a) declares certain areas of Crown land to be reserved land in the class of conservation area; and
- (b) in doing so, creates and names certain new conservation areas and extends an existing conservation area.

(6) Proclamation under section 11(2) of the Nature Conservation Act 2002

This proclamation, made under the Nature Conservation Act 2002 -

- (a) declares certain areas of Crown land to be reserved land in the class of conservation area; and
- (b) in doing so, creates and names certain new conservation areas and extends certain existing conservation areas.
 - (7) Traffic (Compliance and Enforcement) Regulations 2011

These regulations -

- (a) prescribe traffic infringement notice offences for Part IVB of the Traffic Act 1925; and
- (b) prescribe and specify offences for certain other provisions of that Act; and
- (c) provide for certain other compliance and enforcement matters under that Act; and
- (d) rescind the Traffic (Compliance and Enforcement) Regulations 2001 and its amending legislation.
