RULES PUBLICATION ACT 1953

NOTICE OF THE MAKING OF STATUTORY RULES

IN ACCORDANCE with the provisions of the *Rules Publication Act 1953*, notice is given of the making of the following statutory rules:—

GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) *Criminal Amendment Rules 2012*

These Rules of Court amend the *Criminal Rules 2006* to specify procedures in relation to subpoenas, issued in criminal proceedings, to which the *Trans-Tasman Proceedings Act 2010* of the Commonwealth applies.

(2) *Supreme Court Amendment (Trans-Tasman Proceedings) Rules 2012*

These Rules of Court amend the *Supreme Court Rules 2000* by specifying procedures in relation to –

- (a) subpoenas, issued in civil proceedings, to which the *Trans-Tasman Proceedings Act 2010* of the Commonwealth applies; and
- (b) the recognition and enforcement of New Zealand judgments registered under that Act.

(3) *Water Management (Sassafras Wesley Vale Groundwater Area) Order 2012*

This order –

- (a) appoints, names and defines the Sassafras Wesley Vale Groundwater Area; and
- (b) provides that groundwater may not be taken from that groundwater area for commercial purposes without the authority of a licence.
