These Rules of Court amend the Supreme Court Rules 2000 -

- (a) consequentially on the enactment of the Commercial Arbitration Act 2011; and
- (b) in relation to the giving of opinion evidence; and
- (c) in relation to mediation; and
- (d) by updating requirements of the Court in relation to documents; and
- (e) by amending the classes of proceedings that are to be commenced by application to the Court or to a judge in chambers.

(2) Supreme Court Amendment (Miscellaneous) Rules (No. 2) 2012

These Rules of Court amend the Supreme Court Rules 2000 by amending certain provisions relating to -

(a) the discovery and inspection of documents; and

(b) appeals from decisions of the Associate Judge to the Full Court.

(3) Supreme Court Forms Amendment Rules (No. 2) 2012

These Rules of Court amend the Supreme Court Forms Rules 2000 by amending the wording of the affidavit made when verifying a list of documents under the Supreme Court Rules 2000.
