## ANIMAL HEALTH ACT 1995

*Section 18*

### GENERAL AUTHORITY FOR THE IMPORTATION OF BEES AND BEE PRODUCTS

I, Roderick Andrewartha, Chief Veterinary Officer, hereby issue a General Authority for the importation of European Honey Bees and Bee Products.

The following conditions apply:-

1. Queen bees and escort bees may be imported provided that;
  - a. Queen bees and escorts have been sourced from an apiary that has an active surveillance and management plan in place for the control of small hive beetle (*Aethina tumida*); and
  - b. All cages used for the transportation of queen bees are to be new and constructed to ensure small hive beetle cannot gain entry. The cages should have either a mesh with holes less than 2mm x 2mm, or any slots longer than 2 mm are to be no wider than 1mm; and
  - c. The queen cages are to be inspected by the apiarist immediately prior to loading the queen and escort bees and must be free of small hive beetle; and
  - d. The queen bee and escorts are to be hand caught and inspected by the apiarist at the time they are placed in the new queen cage and are to be free of small hive beetle; and
  - e. Once loaded, queen bee cages are to be stored away from bee hives, packaged bees or used bee equipment and are to be transported separate from bee hives, packaged bees or used bee equipment; and
  - f. The outer packaging of consignment of queen bees must have a statement with letters in 28 point font or larger on a contrasting background indicating that the package contains live bees; and
  - g. On arrival in Tasmania the packaging and queen cages are to be inspected for evidence of small hive beetle by an Inspector. If inspection detects no small hive beetle the imported queen bees will be released to the receiving apiarist; and
  - h. If small hive beetle is detected the whole consignment will be held and either destroyed under quarantine supervision or sealed and returned to the state of origin; and
  - i. Tasmanian beekeeper must inspect the queens for small hive beetle prior to placing them in a hive. If there is any evidence of small hive beetle the queen cages must be sealed in a plastic bag and an Inspector notified. Bees or queen cages with evidence of small hive beetles must not be placed in a hive.
2. Substances produced or collected by bees, other than bees wax, honey comb and honey, may be imported without restriction.
3. Honey must come from apiaries free of American foulbrood (*Paenibacillus larvae*) and colonies (hives) not showing any clinical signs of diseases of bees.
4. Bees wax must have been melted and cooled.
5. Honey Comb may not be imported into Tasmania.

6. The consignor of the bees or bee products in the exporting state or territory must certify that, to the best of their knowledge, all of the above conditions have been met.
7. A Government Inspector or other authorized person in the state of origin must certify that after due enquiry, they have no reason to doubt the 'owner declaration' required by condition 6.
8. All certification must be in a form approved by the Chief Veterinary Officer, and must be presented to an inspector when the bees or bee products arrive in Tasmania.

### LIVING MARINE RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ACT 1995

#### Fisheries (Abalone) Rules 2009, Rule 9

#### PUBLIC NOTICE - DATES OF CLOSING OF THE COMMERCIAL BLACKLIP ABALONE FISHERY IN STATE WATERS OFF THE COAST OF THE NORTH-EAST OF TASMANIA

I, ROBERT GOTT, Director (Marine Resources), acting under Rule 9 of the *Fisheries (Abalone) Rules 2009*, and delegated authority under Section 20(1) of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995*, hereby determine:

that the dates of the closed season for the commercial abalone fishery for the taking of blacklip abalone (*Haliotis rubra*) for commercial purpose from State waters off the coast of the north-east of Tasmania are as follows:

- from 7 October 2013 to 31 December 2013, inclusive;

where: "**the north-east**" is defined to mean: those State waters off the north-east coast of Tasmania within an area bounded in the west by an imaginary line beginning where the line of longitude 147° 27' 00" East meets the high-water mark of the north coast of the mainland of Tasmania in Anderson Bay, then running due north until its junction with the line of latitude 40° 39' South, then due east along that line of latitude to the limit of State waters, and bounded in the east by an imaginary line from the northern side of the mouth of the Great Musselroe River at Musselroe Bay running due west for 100 metres, then following the shoreline 100 metres from shore to the northernmost tip of Musselroe Point, then running due north until intersection with the line of latitude 40° 48' 00" South, and running due east to the outer limit of State waters.

#### NOTICE FOR THE TASMANIAN SCALLOP FISHERY COMPRISING ACTIVITIES BY WAY OF FISHING FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES

I, ROB GOTT, Director (Marine Resources), Department of Primary Industries, Parks, Water and Environment, pursuant to the delegated authority under Section 20(1) of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995*, in accordance with the Fisheries (Scallop) Rules 2010, hereby:

1. Determine under Rule 15(1)(a) of the Rules, the dates of the open season for commercial scallop fishery for the area of State waters identified as the White Rock Scallop Area as determined below, is from 9:00am 2 October 2013 to 6:00pm 31 December 2013 (inclusive).
2. Determine that the waters previously determined under Rule 16(1)(a) and 16(1)(b), as published in State newspapers on 21 August 2013 and in Gazette No. 21 360 on 21 August 2013 are now no longer the specified area of the White Rock Scallop Area opened to the commercial scallop fishery:
3. Now determine under Rule 16(1)(a) and 16(1)(b), the specified area of the White Rock Scallop Area to be open to the commercial scallop fishery for commercial scallop dredging are State waters within the following boundary:
  - i. from latitude 42° 30' S, longitude 148° 01.18494' E; to
