(1) *Archives Regulations 2014*

These rules amend the *Fisheries (Commercial Dive) Rules 2011* by –

- (a) removing certain restrictions relating to the holding of a fishing licence (commercial dive); and
- (b) providing that the holder of a fishing licence (commercial dive) endorsed for the use of a fish cauf may place fish taken under the authority of another fishing licence (commercial dive) in his or her fish cauf in certain circumstances.
