VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC ACT 1999

Annual Adjustment Factor for the Financial Year 2015-16

I, M.T. (RENE) HIDDING in accordance with clause 6 of Schedule 2 to the *Vehicle and Traffic Act 1999*, determine the annual adjustment factor for the financial year commencing on 1 July 2015 to be 0.6%.

The annual adjustment factor is used, in accordance with Schedule 2 to the *Vehicle and Traffic Act 1999*, in the calculation of the tax payable for a heavy vehicle.

The annual adjustment factor is based on the formula that is determined by the National Transport Commission, established under the *National Transport Commission Act 2003* of the Commonwealth, in respect of the financial year commencing on 1 July 2015, and reflects changes in the expenditure of state and local governments on roads and expected changes in road use by heavy vehicles.

GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Proclamation under section 2 of the *Conveyancing Amendment Act (No. 2) 2012*

This proclamation fixes 1 May 2015 as the day on which the *Conveyancing Amendment Act (No. 2) 2012* commences.

(2) Proclamation under section 2 of the *Heavy Vehicle National Law (Tasmania) Act 2013*

This proclamation commences section 31 of the *Heavy Vehicle National Law (Tasmania) Act 2013* on 30 March 2015 so that the fatigue management provisions of the Heavy Vehicle National Law apply as a law of this jurisdiction from that date.

(3) Proclamation under section 2 of the *Land Use Planning and Approvals Amendment Act 2013*

This proclamation fixes 1 April 2015 as the day on which sections 36, 37, 38 and 39 of the *Land Use Planning and Approvals Amendment Act 2013* commence.

(4) *Traffic (Compliance and Enforcement) Amendment Regulations 2015*

These regulations –

- (a) amend the *Traffic (Compliance and Enforcement) Regulations 2011* by revising the schedule of traffic infringement notice offences in line with recent changes to the *Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Operations) Regulations 2014* made consequent on the commencement of the fatigue management provisions of the Heavy Vehicle National Law (Tasmania); and
- (b) rescind regulations that have been made redundant by those recent changes.

(5) *Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Operations) Amendment Regulations 2015*

These regulations amend the *Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Operations) Regulations 2014* by rescinding the provisions relating to driving hours, national driver work diaries and driving hours records, consequent on the commencement of the fatigue management provisions of the Heavy Vehicle National Law (Tasmania).
