PROMISSORY OATHS ACT 2015

A PROCLAMATION

I, Professor THE HONOURABLE KATE WARNER, Companion of the Order of Australia, Governor in and over the State of Tasmania and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia DO by this my Proclamation announce and declare that under and by virtue of the power vested in me by section 3(2) of the *Promissory Oaths Act 2015*, I have this day authorised **LAURA ELIZABETH ROSS**, Deputy Clerk of the House of Assembly of the said State, on my behalf to administer to Members of the House of Assembly the Oath of Allegiance prescribed by the *Promissory Oaths Act 2015* to be taken and subscribed by Members of the said Assembly as soon as practicable after becoming such a Member, and, in accordance with section 30 of the *Constitution Act 1934*, before such a Member of the said Assembly may vote or act therein.
