NOTICE OF THE MAKING OF STATUTORY RULES

IN ACCORDANCE with the provisions of the *Rules Publication Act 1953*, notice is given of the making of the following statutory rules:—

GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) *Strategic Infrastructure Corridors (Strategic and Recreational Use) (Transfer of Rail Infrastructure) Notice 2020*

This notice, under section 100(1) of the *Strategic Infrastructure Corridors (Strategic and Recreational Use) Act 2016*, transfers to the Crown all rail infrastructure that is situated on the corridor named the North East Corridor from Lilydale Falls to Tonganah.

(2) *Strategic Infrastructure Corridors (Strategic and Recreational Use) (Corridor Manager) Notice 2020*

This notice under section 29(1) of the *Strategic Infrastructure Corridors (Strategic and Recreational Use) Act 2016* appoints Dorset Council to be the corridor manager in relation to all of the corridor named the North East Corridor from Lilydale Falls to Tonganah and specifies that the manager may manage and develop the corridor for use by walkers, runners, horse riders and persons using bicycles, including power-assisted bicycles

(3) *Strategic Infrastructure Corridors (Strategic and Recreational Use) (Declaration of Substantial Fixed Infrastructure) Notice 2020*

This notice under the *Strategic Infrastructure Corridors (Strategic and Recreational Use) Act 2016* declares various former railway platforms, and a station building, situated within the corridor named the North East Corridor from Lilydale Falls to Tonganah, to be substantial fixed infrastructure.

(4) *Strategic Infrastructure Corridors (Strategic and Recreational Use) (North East Corridor from Lilydale Falls to Tonganah) Notice 2020*

This notice declares an area of land to be a strategic infrastructure corridor and assigns to that corridor the name “North East Corridor from Lilydale Falls to Tonganah”.

(5) *Rail Infrastructure (North-East Line) Order 2020*

This order removes, from the rail network under the *Rail Infrastructure Act 2007*, the part of the North-East Line railway which forms, under the *Strategic Infrastructure Corridors (Strategic and Recreational Use) Act 2016*, the strategic infrastructure corridor known as the North East Corridor, from Lilydale Falls to Tonganah, designated on Plan 10396 in the Central Plan Register.
