GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Proclamation under section 2 of the *Firearms Amendment (Community Safety) Act 2023*This proclamation fixes 1 July 2024 as the day on which certain provisions of that Act commence.

- (2) Proclamation under section 2 of the Sentencing Amendment (Breaches of Home Detention Orders) Act 2023

 This proclamation fixes 1 July 2024 as the day on which that Act commences.
- (3) Proclamation under section 2 of the Family Violence Reforms Act 2022

This proclamation fixes 30 June 2024 as the day on which the remaining provisions of that Act commence.

(4) Proclamation under section 2 of the Electoral Matters (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 2023

This proclamation fixes the days on which the provisions of that Act commence.

(5) Proclamation under section 2 of the Electoral Disclosure and Funding Act 2023

This proclamation -

- (a) fixes 1 July 2024 as the day on which provisions relating to the appropriation of money for certain matters under that Act commence; and
- (b) fixes 1 July 2025 as the day on which the remaining provisions of that Act commence.
- (6) Proclamation under section 2 of the *Residential Building (Miscellaneous Consumer Protection Amendments) Act 2023*This proclamation fixes 1 July 2024 as the day on which Parts 1, 6 and 7 of that Act commence.
- (7) Proclamation under section 2 of the *Vehicle and Traffic (Regulatory Reforms) Amendment Act 2023*This proclamation fixes 1 July 2024 as the day on which the provisions of that Act commence.
- (8) Administrative Arrangements Amendment Order 2024

This order amends the Administrative Arrangements Order 2024 by transferring responsibility for the administration of -

- (a) certain Acts relating to Forestry from the Department of Natural Resources and Environment Tasmania to the Department of State Growth; and
- (b) the Tourism Tasmania Act 1996 from the Department of State Growth to Tourism Tasmania; and
- (c) the Roads and Jetties Act 1935 from the Minister for Transport to the Minister for Infrastructure.
- (9) State Service (Restructuring) Order 2024

This order amalgamates certain parts of the Department of Natural Resources and Environment Tasmania, that relate to forestry, with the Department of State Growth.

(10) Health (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2024

These regulations amend the *Health (Fees) Regulations 2017* by increasing certain fees that may be charged in respect of non-nursing-home-type patients for certain hospital services.

(11) Work Health and Safety Amendment (Engineered Stone) Regulations 2024

These regulations amend the Work Health and Safety Regulations 2022 to provide for -

- (a) a prohibition on the use of engineered stone slabs, panels and benchtops; and
- (b) transitional arrangements in relation to engineered stone contracts that were entered into on or before 31 December 2023; and
- (c) a national notification framework for managing work with legacy engineered stone products; and
- (d) a national framework for exempting engineered stone products from the prohibition.
