### **RULES PUBLICATION ACT 1953**

NOTICE OF THE MAKING OF STATUTORY RULES

In accordance with the provisions of the Rules Publication Act 1953, notice is given of the making of the following statutory rules:-

# GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Operations) Regulations 2024

These regulations -

- (a) make provision in relation to -
  - (i) the mass and dimension limits of vehicles; and
  - (ii) the towing of vehicles; and
  - (iii) loads on vehicles; and
  - (iv) driving hours; and
  - (v) the issuing of exemptions; and
  - (vi) other miscellaneous matters; and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Operations) Regulations 2014* under section 11(2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.
- (2) Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Standards) Regulations 2024

These regulations -

- (a) prescribe nationally consistent vehicle standards for Tasmania and generally set out the obligations that drivers and other vehicle users have in relation to those standards; and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Standards) Regulations 2014* under section 11(2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.
